- ❖ Section 37-1.03: CONSTRUCTION covers construction requirements for seal coats
- Section 37-1.03A: General details general construction requirements for seal coats
- ❖ Section 37-1.03B: Equipment details equipment requirements for seal coats
- ❖ Section 37-1.04: PAYMENT not used covered in individual sections

  - Chip seal aggregate retention requirements and related test methods
  - Emulsion quality requirements and related tests are covered in other sections and so are not mentioned here



- □ Section 37-2.01C covers construction
  - General requirements
  - Equipment requirements
  - Surface preparation
  - Placement requirements
    - ✓ General placement requirements
    - ✓ Asphaltic emulsion/binder application
    - ✓ Aggregate spreading
    - ✓ Finishing, Traffic control, sweeping
    - ✓ Excess aggregate disposal, chip seal maintenance



Section 37-2 Chip Seals

Section 37-2.01D – covers payment

➤ Sections 37-2.01A – D: apply to all types of chip seals – i.e. Section 37-2.02 through Section 37-2.07

  - ✓ Section 37-2.03 Polymer Modified Asphaltic Emulsion Chip Seals
  - ✓ Section 37-2.01 General (applicable to all types of Chip Seals)
  - ✓ Section 37-1 General (applicable to all types of Seal Coats)
  - ✓ Section 36 1 General (applicable to all surfacings and pavements)
  - **✓** Divisions I, II and XI (applicable to all projects)
